- During the first 6 months new graduates spend 4 days per week in clinic attendance and 1 day training per week.
- Clinic attendance will rotate around the following disciplines:

Diagnostic imaging and ultrasound

Emergency medicine

All new graduates will be enrolled in the Improve International CPD course:

Foundation Certificate - Accelerated Emergency and Critical Care program
70 hours of on-line training plus additional discussion forums

All new graduates will attend the following courses:

- 2 days practical abdominal ultrasound training
- Cardiac and Thoracic on-line radiology course
- Fear free certification
- Recover initiative CPR training

Training days will focus on the following subjects:

- Client engagement and how to maximise client compliance.

- Systematic case approach, differential diagnosis.
- Pharmacy - Lets get upto speed on the must use products.
- Hospitalisation - How to maximise treatment outcomes.
Practical surgery techniques.
Mental health - How to manage your stress.

In the 2nd 6 months of the first year new graduates will consolidate their clinical skills on the rota and attend the Emergency Night Shift rota.

At the start of the 2nd year they will be given the opportunity to start an Improve International CPD Certificate co-paid by the AMC.

Package

Travel, work visa and Veterinary Surgeons Board registration support

Flights, visa costs, quarantine and first year shared accommodation provided.

Working hours:

First year:

First 6 months – 4 days rota attendance and 1 day training per week

Second 6 months – 7 night shifts followed by 7 days off, and then 2 weeks rota attendance.

Second year and thereafter:

4, 4.5, or 5 days per rota attendance depending on preference, combined with Night shift rota.

Training : all training fees paid in first year

Holiday: 4 weeks per year
